- A. In 2007 Chevy/ GMC produced two body styles. The “old” style is the same as 2006 and is labeled “Classic”. The “new” style does not have the “Classic” label.
 - 1. Does not include: 2007 GM “Classic” pickups.
 - 2. When mounting a G2 Series liftgate on a 2011-2014 model year Chevy/GMC 2500/3500 pickup, the liftgate will need to be positioned 1/2” to 1” rearward to avoid the factory hitch. A filler strip may be needed to fill the gap (not included in the mounting kit).
 - 3. This application positions the liftgate up to 5” rearward to accommodate the factory hitch. A filler strip is included in the mounting kit to bridge the gap.
