

# EXTENDED vs NON-EXTENDED

## Commercial Vans



Extended commercial vans have a longer body length, behind the rear axle, that must be determined prior to ordering a Tommy Gate V2 Internal Van Liftgate or Cantilever Liftgate.

An easy way to determine if a commercial van is an extended or non-extended model is to measure from the center of the rear axle to the back of the van bumper. Please see the below rendering and chart to determine if a commercial van is an extended or non-extended model.
