## NOTES:

- A. In 2007 Chevy/ GMC produced two body styles. The “old” style is the same as 2006 and is labeled “Classic”. The “new” style does not have the “Classic” label.
- B. In 2019 Chevy/ GMC produced two body styles of 1500 pickups. The “old” style is the same as 2018 and has a badge on the tailgate: “LD” (Chevy) or “Limited” (GMC). The “new” style does not have either of these badges.
  1. Does not include: 2007 GM “Classic” pickups.
  2. Includes: 2019 Chevy 1500 “LD” and GMC 1500 “Limited” pickups.
  3. Does not include: 2019 Chevy 1500 “LD” and GMC 1500 “Limited” pickups.
  4. When mounting a G2 Series liftgate on a 2011-2014 model year Chevy/GMC 2500/3500 pickup, the liftgate will need to be positioned 1/2” to 1” rearward to avoid the factory hitch. A filler strip may be needed to fill the gap (not included in the mounting kit).
  5. This application positions the liftgate up to 5” rearward to accommodate the factory hitch. A filler strip is included in the mounting kit to bridge the gap.
